THE GATEKEEPER DISCIPLING

PROCESS KICKS OFF IN AUSTRALIA

With this in mind, the FGBA leaders attending the leadership weekend in Melbourne in February this year unanimously agreed to be discipled for a year as part of their preparation to becoming disciplers, to bring uniformity of vision, mission and purpose to gate meetings and marketplace activities in order to effectively disciple gatekeepers.

They agreed that Dr George Perry, who is being discipled by 'Papa' Khoo Oon Theam, President of FGB Gatekeepers Singapore and also their Director of Leadership Discipling, lead the Gatekeeper Discipling Process.

To ensure the disciples get the best for their preparation, George has already travelled to Singapore several times over the past year to be personally discipled. Regular one-on-one meetings between disciplers and their disciples are essential for the success of the discipling process. He plans to continue to visit Singapore.

Christians experience salvation through evangelism but disciples experience transformation through empowerment, equipping, and enlarging the Kingdom of God. Salvation can take only seconds to happen. as demonstrated by the thief on the cross. But discipling is a lifetime process.

An ideal disciple of Christ is a "true son in the faith", with a spirit of sonship. Sons of our Abba Father refer to both sons and daughters. Their disciplers are those with a father's heart. For discipling women, those with a mother's heart participate in the discipling process. However, to be a father, one must first be a son.

Discipling is different from mentoring. Mentoring is about the mind, and knowledge and understanding while discipling is about the heart. wisdom and revelation. Furthermore, discipling is not just about the church, but about the Kingdom of God in its entirety.

Discipling focuses on the whole person, and prepares them for the work of the Kingdom in their relevant spheres of influence, that is, in arts entertainment and sports; business and finance: church and religion: distribution media and communications; education; family; and government and legal.

Included in the discipling process are the operation of the 8Ws at gate meetings and in personal devotion time, and teaching on the Word Theme for the month. These monthly Word Themes help to bring the richness of life in the Kingdom of God into the disciples.

FGB Gatekeepers Singapore has recently celebrated the conclusion of its first season of their Gatekeeper Discipling Process and welcomed in its second season. There were at least 18 hours of one-on-one meetings between the disciples and their disciplers, usually three hours each month. Both disciplers and disciples had nothing but praise. As commented by Chong Huimin, a young gatekeeper being discipled, the process was as iron sharpening



iron, benefitting both the disciplers and their

Summary of the book of Esther

King Artaxerxes, ruler of a massive Persian empire, holds a lavish party, initially for his court and dignitaries and afterwards for all inhabitants of the capital city Shushan. Artaxerxes gets drunk and orders the queen Vashti to display her beauty before the guests. She refuses. Worried all women will learn from this, Artaxerxes removes her as gueen and has a royal decree sent across the empire that men should be the ruler of their households

Artaxerxes then orders all beautiful young women to be presented to him, so he can choose a new gueen to replace Vashti. One of these is the orphan Jewish girl Esther. After the death of her parents, she is being fostered by her cousin Mordecai. She finds favour in the king's eyes, and is made his new queen. Esther does not reveal that she is Jewish.

Shortly afterwards, Mordecai discovers a plot by the Kings body guards to assassinate King Artaxerxes, the conspirators are apprehended and hanged, and Mordecai's service to the king is recorded in the courts daily records

Artaxerxes appoints Haman one of his officials as his prime minister. Mordecai, who sits at the palace gates, falls into Haman's disfavour as he refuses to bow down to him. Having found out that Mordecai is Jewish Haman plans to kill not just Mordecai but all the Jews in the empire. He obtains Artaxerxes permission to execute this plan, and he casts lots to choose the date on which to do this—the thirteenth of the month of March. On that day, everyone in the empire is free to massacre the Jews and take their land.

When Mordecai finds out about the plans he and all Jews mourn and fast. Mordecai informs Esther what has happened and tells her to intercede with the King. She is afraid to break the law and go to the King unsummoned. She replies that nobody is allowed to approach the king, under penalty of

Mordecai warns her that she must, and he said that she will not be any safer in the palace than any other Jew, and says that if she keeps silent, salvation for the Jews will come from somewhere else, but "you and your house hold will perish," and he suggests that she was elevated to this position of authority as queen, for such a time as this.

Esther has a change of heart, She orders Mordecai to have all Jews fast for three days together with her, so as the Lord would give her favour with the King. And on the third day she goes to Artaxerxes who stretches out his sceptre to her which shows that she is not to be punished.

She invites him to a feast in the company of Haman. During the feast, she asks them to attend a further feast the next evening. Meanwhile, Haman is again offended in some way by Mordecai and consults with his friends. At his wife's suggestion, he builds a gallows for Mordecai.

That night, Artaxerxes can't sleep and when the court records are read to him to help him sleep, he learns of the services rendered by Mordecai in the previous plot against his life. Artaxerxes is told that Mordecai has not received any recognition for saving the king's life.

Just then, Haman appears, to ask the King to hang Mordecai, but before he can make this request, King Artaxerxes asks Haman for his advice. He asks, what should be done for the man that the king wishes to honour. Thinking that the man that the king is referring to is himself, Haman says that the man should be dressed in the king's royal robes and led around on the king's royal horse, while a herald calls: "See how the king honours a man he wishes to reward!" To his horror and surprise, the king instructs Haman to do so to Mordecai. After leading Mordecai's parade, he returns in mourning to his wife and friends, who suggest his downfall

Immediately after, Artaxerxes and Haman attend Esther's second banquet, Esther reveals that she is Jewish and that Haman is planning to exterminate her people, including her. Overcome by rage, Artaxerxes leaves the room. Meanwhile, Haman stavs behind and begs Esther for his life, falling upon her in desperation

The king comes back in at this moment and thinks Haman is assaulting the queen. This makes him angrier than before, and he orders Haman hanged on the gallows that Haman had prepared for

The previous decree against the Jews cannot be annulled, but the king allows the Jews to defend themselves during attacks. As a result, on 13 February 500 attackers and Haman's ten sons are killed in Shushan, followed by a Jewish slaughter of 75,000 Persians, although they took no plunder.

Esther sends a letter instituting an annual commemoration of the Jewish people's redemption in a holiday called Purim. Artaxerxes remains very powerful and continues reigning, with Mordecai assuming a prominent position in his court.
